Applicants with a bachelor's degree, as well as people with a higher professional education, confirmed by the assignment of the qualification "certified specialist", have the right to participate in the competition for places funded from the budget allocations of the federal budget. Admission is based on an entrance test.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

From the compulsory subjects Master's students study: Methodology and Methods of Scientific Research, Psychology of Project Management, Planning of Theoretical and Empirical Research, Statistical Methods in Psychology, Foreign Language (Professional), Current Problems of Theory and Practice of Modern Psychology, etc.

Eight elective subjects are offered to Master's students. The main types of educational activities are lectures and laboratory classes. Practical training and research work are provided in each semester.

The program is finished by the writing of the master's thesis.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

The field of professional activity of graduates includes general educational organizations, educational organizations of secondary vocational education and educational organizations of higher education. Graduates can continue their postgraduate studies.
