PROGRAM STRUCTURE

1st year. Mastering stable skills of speech production in foreign languages, taking into account their phonetic organization, tempo, norm and style of the language.

2nd year. Formation of skills in the application of translation transformations to achieve the necessary level of equivalence and representativeness when performing all types of translation.

3rd year. Learning to perceive authentic speech by ear at a natural pace for native speakers, regardless of the peculiarities of pronunciation and the speech channel.

4th year. Adequate application of the rules for constructing texts in working languages to achieve their coherence, consistency, and integrity based on compositional speech forms.

5th year. Mastery of all communication registers: official, unofficial, neutral and recognition of linguistic markers of social relations, as well as their adequate use (formulas-greetings, goodbyes, expressions of emotions, etc.)
