## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants with a bachelor's degree, as well as people with a higher professional education, confirmed by the assignment of the qualification "certified specialist", have the right to participate in the competition for places funded from the budget allocations of the federal budget. Admission is based on an entrance test.

## PROGRAM STRUCTURE

From the range of general subjects, Masters study a professional foreign language, methods and methods of political analysis, the political system in modern Russia, the peculiarities of the organization of state authority and political management in the Russian Federation, regional political processes, modern public policy and organization and conduct of political audit.

Students are offered 4 elective courses. The main types of educational activities are lectures and practical classes. Practical training and research work are provided in each semester. The final academic assessment provides for the passing of a comprehensive state exam and the defense of the master's thesis.

## CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Masters are trained to carry out organizational and managerial, expert-analytical, consulting and informational activities in the field of politics. They also can work in institutions of higher and secondary special education.
