ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants with a bachelor's degree, as well as people with a higher professional education, confirmed by the assignment of the qualification "certified specialist", have the right to participate in the competition for places funded from the budget allocations of the federal budget. Admission is based on an entrance test.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

From the general disciplines, Master's students study a foreign language, information and communication technologies in the field of social work, and social culture.

The program includes disciplines aimed at studying the technology of scientific inquiry, research methodology in the field of social work.

The main part of the disciplines reveals features of the theory and practice of social work management, directions of intersectoral interaction; features of social control and social expertise in social work, problems of demography and social policy. Master's students analyze social programs and projects, innovative technologies of social work.

Students are offered 10 elective disciplines reflecting different aspects of social work organization. The programme includes research and practical training. The programme concludes with the defence of the Master's thesis.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Masters are prepared to work in the social welfare and social services system and have the opportunity to enrol in postgraduate courses.
