# PROGRAM STRUCTURE

In the first year, students study disciplines of historical and cultural block, the theory of international relations, and two foreign languages.

In the second year, students begin an in-depth study of the international political block disciplines (Fundamentals of Foreign Policy, International Organizations and Institutions, etc.). In the second year, a third foreign language is added.

In the third year, disciplines of management and organizational profile (Public Protocol and Business Etiquette, Organizational and Corporate Culture, etc.) are added to the disciplines of specialization (World Politics, Theory and History of Diplomacy, Integration Processes: History and Modernity).

In the fourth year, bachelors continue studying three foreign languages and mastering such disciplines as International Conflicts: History and the Present, Russia in Global Politics, Basics of International Security.
