ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants with a bachelor's degree, as well as people with a higher professional education, confirmed by the assignment of the qualification "certified specialist", have the right to participate in the competition for places funded from the budget allocations of the federal budget. PROGRAM STRUCTURE

Among the subjects of the compulsory part, Bachelors study Russian history, foreign language, philosophy, jurisprudence, political science, etc. The psychological and pedagogical module includes the theory of training and education, general, age, pedagogical and social psychology, basics of counseling activities, etc. The theoretical and methodological module includes computer science and information technology, economics, basics of project management, etc.

The substantive module includes courses on archaeology, the history of primitive society, the history of Russia, the history of the ancient world, the Middle Ages, the new and modern times, the theory and methodology of history. The curriculum includes elective disciplines (historical portraits, cultural history of the Eastern Christian civilization, classical languages in the history of European tradition). The main types of educational activities are lectures and practical classes. Research work is provided in each semester.
