PROGRAM STRUCTURE

In the first year students study foreign language, computer science and information technology, philosophy, Russian language and culture of speech, history of Russia, economics, law, sociology; introduction to the profession of social worker, history of social work). Along with the compulsory disciplines, elective courses are studied, allowing to master the skills of independent work, volunteer work and project management.

The disciplines of the second, third and fourth years form the ability to analyse the social situation, implement social service technologies, forecast and socially design professional activities, implement social support measures, organise social services and the activities of a social service unit.

Graduates are in demand in the social welfare and social services sector; in the socio-cultural sector; in social insurance and pension provision; in the social services system; and can continue their studies in Master's programs.
