ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants with a bachelor's degree, as well as people with a higher professional education, confirmed by the assignment of the qualification "certified specialist", have the right to participate in the competition for places funded from the budget allocations of the federal budget. PROGRAM STRUCTURE

Students receive general research training to plan and conduct theoretical and applied research on culture and its representation in the media; they learn fundamental theoretical disciplines in culture and media, as well as practical training in the professional and creative duties of media content production, involving the development of media projects and supervision of their implementation; development of the concept, model, format of a publication, television and radio programs, column, and media programs. The program also includes theoretical and practical training in the development of socio-cultural events and media support.
