ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

Year 1: In the first year students, study the general subjects. The main aim is mastering two foreign languages (German and English). Students also learn Latin, basics of linguistics, general subjects of the humanities cycle, physical education.

Year 2: In the second year students, study two foreign languages, theory of intercultural communication, history, geography, culture and literature of the first and second foreign languages, pedagogics, psychology, physical culture.

Year 3: during the 3rd year students study two foreign languages (German: practical, professional, business; English: practical), academic writing (in Russian and in a foreign language), theory and methods of teaching first and second foreign languages and pedagogics.

Year 4: during the fourth year students study two foreign languages (German: practical, professional, business; English: practical). They have industrial pedagogical practice and defend the final qualification work.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Graduates of the program can work in the public and private sectors of primary and secondary education, in specialized linguistic schools, gymnasiums and lyceums, colleges, language schools and foreign language courses.
