PROGRAM STRUCTURE

In the first year the main profile subjects are studied: Current problems of philosophical anthropology, Current problems of cultural philosophy, History and theory of philosophical anthropology, Human problem in history of culture and philosophy, Human ontology in Russian philosophy, Methodology of philosophical and anthropological research. The coursework and the first research internship are done. The theme and structure of Master's thesis are clarified. The coursework and the first research internship are being carried out. The second year begins with the study of Methods of Teaching Philosophy on the basis of the mastered Pedagogy of Higher Education and the Pedagogical Practicum. In the final term, most of the time is devoted to the preparation of the thesis as part of the research work and pre-graduation practical training. Special courses in Philosophical and Applied Hermeneutics, Religious-Philosophical Anthropology, The Problem of Man and Society in the Classical Philosophical Tradition, Philosophy and Anthropology of Power, Philosophy of Dialogue, etc. are studied.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Graduate masters receive recommendations to continue their postgraduate studies. They are provided with support for employment in educational organisations of general, vocational, higher and further education; media editorial offices, museums and libraries; public authorities, public organisations and commercial structures.
